## STORIES FOR A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE

The “#WhatDoYouCareAbout” storybook is part of the multimedia project “European Footprints” on sustainable development that involves former **European Commission trainees**. It is a teaching tool to be used in classrooms or educational workshops for students (13-18 yo) and includes:

**31** **STORIES** of passions, grass-roots initiatives or projects by young Europeans from 28 European countries. They can be read all together as an introduction to sustainable development, as well as independent examples of citizens’ initiatives.

**3** **THEMES** for a holistic approach to sustainable development, complementary to the 3 videos of the European Footprints’ project: [nature and climate](#) + [society](#) + [education and well-being](#).

**10** **THEMATIC CLUSTERS** to tackle all aspects of sustainability, from climate change to responsible life choices, from waste to social inclusion and education...

**DYK** **DID YOU KNOW, FACTS, QUESTIONS** as additional teaching resources on sustainable development, citizens’ initiatives, European and international organisations.

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### USE THE STORYBOOK...

- ... to fire up a discussion by reading the stories, questions and facts.
- ... by picking a theme/subject and comparing the stories and given examples.
- ... as an English language tool: all stories are in English!
- ... to talk about Europe, EU, civil initiatives or to introduce EU programs.
- ... for a creative writing class, by making students write their own stories.
- ... to inspire students to create their own initiatives and projects!
